ADMISSION & PROGRAMS

All seating is general admission. Tickets are available in-person only. Cash and card accepted. \$10 adults (13+) • \$8 seniors, military, under 12 • FREE children under 5 • \$5 Programs
The daytime and evening contests have separate paid admission wristbands.

PARKING

Riverside City College event parking is \$5, paid at machines or parking officers. Cash and card accepted. **Spectators** use the parking structure off Magnolia Avenue and Terracina Drive. **Handicap and WBA Staff** parking is in LOT Y, access from Magnolia Avenue and 15th Street, then keep right onto Stadium Way to the lower level, adjacent to handball courts. **Buses and Trucks** park in LOT E and LOT G, enter from Olivewood Avenue and Saunders Street. Only busses, semis, box trucks, and vehicles towing equipment trailers are allowed in this lot. **Band Staff** driving separately must use the parking structure.

CONCESSIONS

There will be an assortment of food, drinks, and snacks available to all. Cash and card accepted.
****GRILLS AND OPEN FIRES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CAMPUS OR IN PARKING LOTS****

CHECK-IN

Located at the front corner of LOT E bus/truck parking lot, look for EZ-up and signage. Your packet will contain a free program and performer wristbands for student seating areas (see *stadium map*). Directors, Staff, Media, Pit Crew/Chaperones must use their WBA Credential for access to stadium. Performers and chaperones cannot sit on the home side unless they have purchased a spectator wristband. Pit Crew/Chaperone passes only grant access to stadium for performance. Access to seating area requires a paid spectator wristband.

RESTROOMS

There will be portable restrooms in the bus/truck parking area LOT E as well as Huntley Gym locker room. The stadium has restrooms on the home and away side.

HOSPITALITY

There will be Director/Staff hospitality at the west end of the stadium just outside of the track.

FIRST AID

Basic first aid is available at the merchandise tent outside the stadium home side bleachers. For moderate issues, call RCC Police dispatch (951) 222-8171. For severe emergencies call 911. The nearest hospital is Riverside Community Hospital, located across the street from RCC. 4445 Magnolia Avenue, Riverside, CA 92501. (951) 788-3000

WARM-UP

Musical warmups may take place throughout the empty parking lot areas in LOT F and LOT P or tennis courts and are unassigned. NO warmup on the upper campus due to Saturday classes and theatre events. Colorguards can use the tennis courts or football practice field next to the parking structure. *From the bus/truck parking lots, please allow 5-10 minutes for comfortable transit time to the performance gate.*

PROP STAGING / BAND ENTRY

LOT K near the scoreboard (*east end of stadium, side two*). Bands will enter and exit the stadium via this gate. Pits should follow the outside track lanes toward the front of the field.

Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the track, only use the field turf and carpet path.

PERFORMER RE-ENTRY

Unfortunately, our home side grandstands are not large enough to accommodate paid spectators and student performers. All bands have assigned seating on the visitor side bleachers or side two endzone area. Students and chaperones may (re)enter their seating area at the performance entrance gate. Please only sit in your assigned area as labeled (*see stadium map*). There can be NO food or drinks (except water) in the track seating area only. Backside bleachers may have full food and drinks.

STAFF VIEW/SOUND MIXING

Top of the stands underneath the press box area for staff view and sound mixing. Each band may have ONE individual record their performance only and must have their media pass visible.

FIELD & HASH MARKS

Out astroturf field has college/NCAA hash marks at 60' and 100' from the front sideline. **High school has marks will be yellow tape at 53'4" and 106'8" from the front sideline.**

ELECTRICAL POWER

Power will be available at the 50 front sideline. It is your responsibility to have back-up power.

PRESSBOX

Our pressbox is about 15 yards off center towards the side two 35. Judges will be on top of and inside the pressbox. It is up to you whether your orientation is “straight ahead” (*as if a centered pressbox*) or angled towards our pressbox. The majority of groups ignore our pressbox and face straight ahead.

DRUM MAJORS & AWARDS

This event has separate daytime and evening award ceremonies. The Marching Tigers will perform and the end of each event, and prior to awards. All student leaders are invited to watch the Marching Tigers performance from the front sideline track area. Immediately following RCC’s performance student leaders should meet back at the scoreboard (*at the performance entrance gate*) to assemble for retreat.

ADJUDICATION & COMMENTARY

Adjudicators and scoring system are provided by Western Band Association. WBA uses *Competition Suite* for commentary and score recaps. Make sure you and your staff have access before the event. Please refer to the WBA website for rules regulations, and policies.
