### **DIRECTIONS:**

**Be sure to follow these directions to arrive in the correct bus entrance.**

**Busses and support vehicles from each school must *arrive together* or we cannot guarantee they will be *parked together*.**

### **From the Riverside area:**

Take the 60 West past the 57 FWY. Exit Nogales and turn Left going south. Turn Left on Colima then turn Right on Otterbein.

### **From the San Gabriel Valley area:**

Take the 10 East to the 605 South to the 60 East. Exit Nogales and turn Right going south. Turn Left on Colima then turn Right on Otterbein.

### **From the Orange County area:**

Take the 57 North and exit Diamond Bar Blvd and turn Left. Turn Left on Pathfinder then Right on Alexdale. Turn Left on Valencia then turn Right on Otterbein.

### **WBA PASSES, CHAPERONE AND STUDENT ENTRANCE**

Bands are required to use their WBA staff passes issued to them earlier this year. WBA Staff Passes are good for entrance into the stadium. Based on the publicity sheet, performing student members will be given a wristband in the director's packet. Per WBA guidelines, participating schools have already received WBA Chaperone Passes. Only chaperones and field helpers with a WBA Chaperone Pass will be allowed free entrance and must sit on the visitor's side of the stadium with their school. The videographer for your unit must have the WBA Media Pass to gain free entrance and access into the stadium press box to record your school's performance only! Any chaperone or pit helper without a wristband will be asked to purchase a ticket for entrance into the stadium.

### **PLEASE REFER TO THE MAP AS TO WHAT LOT TO PARK IN**

### **ARRIVAL/CHECK IN:**

Upon your arrival, we will provide wristbands to all Students. *Performing students and chaperons will sit on the south side of the stadium.* Please gauge your arrival time to meet the needs of unloading, dressing, and warming-up in preparation for your performance.

### **ADMISSION:**

Tickets can be purchased at the Ticket Booth located near the south end of the stadium. A purchased ticket is valid for the entire show. Ticket prices are \$12 for adults, \$7 for children under 12 years old, \$7 for seniors over 65 years old, \$7 for Military personnel (in uniform or identification) and free for children under 5 years old. Programs are \$6. This year, we will accept debit and credit cards.

### **CONCESSION STAND:**

A variety of food and beverages will be on sale to your students, chaperones and band parents. Please ADVISE your students and parents that these items will be sold on the East side of the stadium.

**ABSOLUTELY NO ICE CHESTS, FOOD OR DRINK WILL BE ALLOWED INTO ROWLAND STADIUM. The Rowland Unified School District PROHIBITS COOKING/FOOD PREPARATION in their PARKING LOTS. You are asked to adhere to this policy. This is a fundraiser event and we encourage all participants to support the Rowland High School Band by purchasing food at the concession stands in the stadium.**

### **VENDOR BOOTHS**

We have retained the services of several vendors located outside the stadium gates. Encourage your students and parents to patronize and support all the vendors at the tournament.

### **WARM UP AND REHEARSAL AREAS**

Please use the upper field, quad area and any other areas on campus to warm-up, observing all silent zones and facing away from the stadium. The tennis courts are a quiet zone and are reserved as a guard warm-up area only. Again, there will be NO room for rehearsing in the parking lot. There will not be a concern unless the band warming-up interferes with the performing bands or other bands in the warm-up area. Please be aware of your time as your group proceeds to the warmup area, staging area and ultimately the performance field.

### **PIT EQUIPMENT AND TOW VEHICLES**

Vehicles used to tow pit equipment and/or props, which will be allowed on the rubber track ONLY, may not be larger than a golf cart or quad AND must be operated by an adult.

**NO CARS OR TRUCKS ARE ALLOWED IN THE STADIUM AND  
NO VEHICLE OF ANY KIND IS ALLOWED ON THE ARTIFICIAL TURF FIELD!!!**

This is a Rowland Unified School District policy so please make sure your pit parents are aware of this special restriction. Your cooperation in this matter would greatly be appreciated.

### **BAND ANNOUNCEMENT AND ENTRANCE**

Your band will be announced from the information provided on your application and at check-in. New this year, WBA has standardized the introductory announcement. Please refer to the WBA Handbook should you have any questions. In the event of inclement weather, the show will be moved into the gymnasium and a judged stand still performance will take place.

### **PERFORMER & CHAPERONE SEATING**

ALL performing members and chaperones are required to sit on the visitor side of the stadium, until that seating area is full, at which time your school will be directed to a selected seating area. Please make sure that all performers wear a wristband provided in the packet and chaperones have a WBA Chaperone Pass in order to gain access to the visitor's side of the stadium

### **VIDEO TAPING:**

***NO taping will be allowed from the top of the press box.***

### **SEATING CHART:**

Bands will sit in the visitor side stands.

### **PARKING:**

Since busses will take most of the lot at the school, parents will have to park around the school in the neighborhood streets. Parking will be available at Killian Elementary School on Lerona Ave. south of Killian Ave. (2 blocks west of Rowland HS). We will keep you informed if additional parking lots become available. Handicap & Judges will be in the stadium lot.

### **ADJUDICATION FORMS:**

We will be using the WBA "Caption Sheets".

### **AWARDS CEREMONY:**

Please send your leaders to the fifty-yard line on the visitor's side immediately after the last band's performance.

### **WARM-UP:**

Full band warm-up, color guard warm-up and percussion warm-ups can be done in the school (in all warm up areas, instruments MUST face away from the stadium). You may warm up in these areas as long as you wish. It is your responsibility to move to the final staging area on time! (NORTH EAST END OF STADIUM).

**IMPORTANT! WE ASK THAT YOUR PERFORMANCE GROUP BE PREPARED TO MOVE AT LEAST 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO YOUR PERFORMANCE TIME. ANY UNIT IN THE STAGING AREA OR ANY OTHER AREA OTHER THAN THE WARM UP AREA, WHICH INTERFERES WITH A COMPETING UNIT DURING THEIR PERFORMANCE, MAY BE GIVEN A 1.0 PENALTY OFF THE BAND SHEET. THIS PENALTY MAY BE GIVEN AFTER THE FIRST WARNING AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT WARNING.**

**CHANGING AREAS:**

All uniform changing must be done in your vehicles or in the restrooms on campus.

**HOSPITALITY:**

There will be a section on the map for Band Directors and Staff personnel with WBA passes ONLY! Please advise your organization that this is a private area to all Band Directors and Staff. The Rowland Band Boosters will provide meals in our Hospitality area.

**FIRST AID:**

There will be a designated area for basic first aid. Room P-3 near the band entrance on North East side of the stadium.

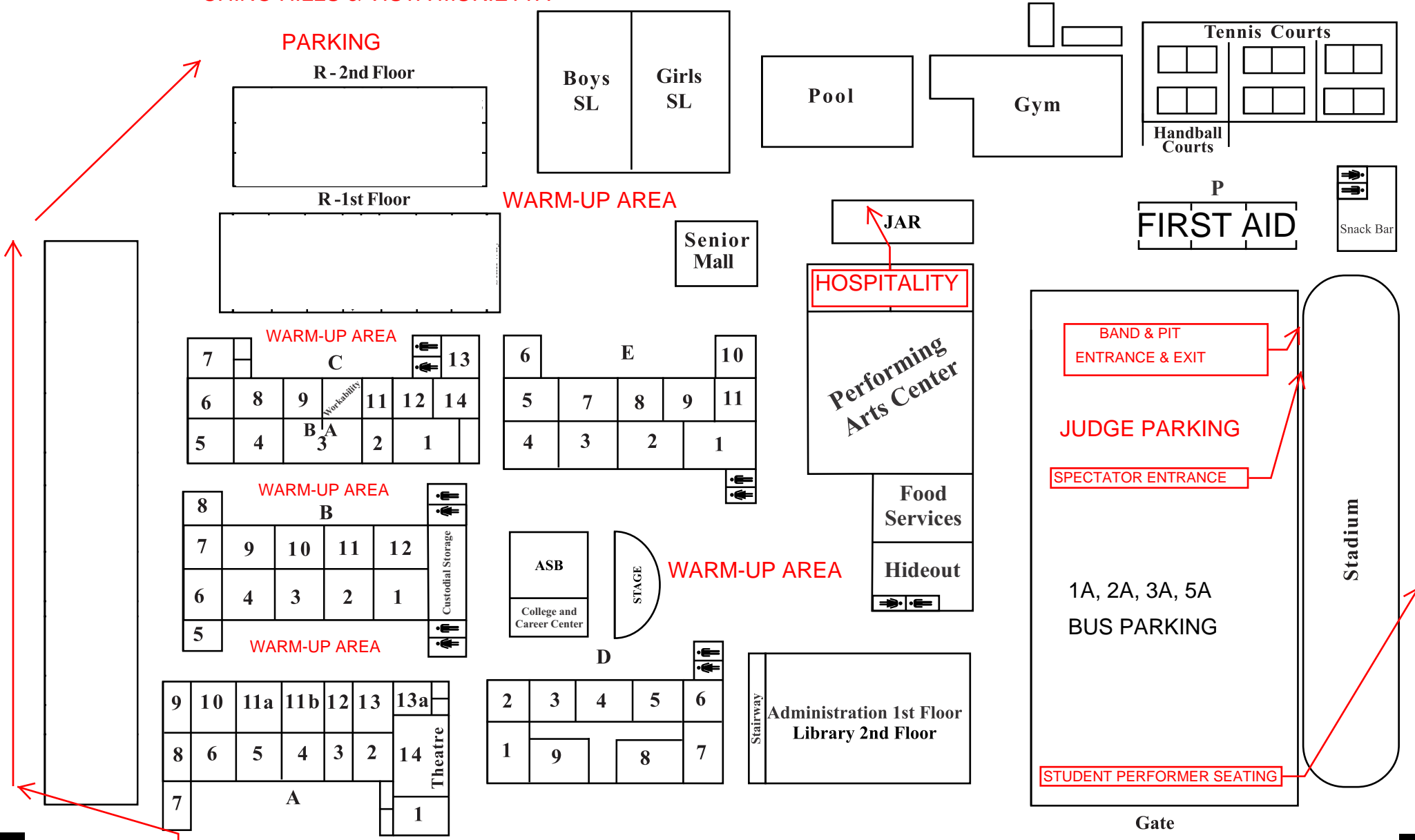
